TRAINERSHIP GUIDELINES

The training course of the Master's Degree in Nutritional Science (SNM) includes the carrying out of internship activities defined as 'Curricular Internship' aimed at completing the student's training. This internship activity (6 credits, 150 hours) must be carried out in public or private healthcare facilities operating in the nutrition sector and public or private companies operating in the food sector with which the University of Calabria has stipulated agreements, if these satisfy the specific educational requirements of the Degree Course.

The internship activity must be carried out during the second year and must be certified by the structure hosting the intern.

The Coordinator is responsible for organizing the curricular internship activities. The coordinator can delegate another professor or researcher (academic tutor) related to the Course, who will propose the availability of the host institutions to the students and address their requests. In order to apply for a Curricular Internship, Students must have acquired a number of credits equal to 54 ECTS. The student can extend the Curricular Internship activity by dedicating an additional 3 credits among those proposed for the training activities chosen by the student. The Department of Pharmacy, Health and Nutritional Sciences has appointed a Departmental Internship Commission composed of delegates belonging to the Degree Course to propose available offers to students, to regulate and direct their request, record the internship carried out, following a positive evaluation of the host structure through a judgment of 'satisfactory/unsatisfactory'. The curricular internship can also be carried out abroad according to the regulations set out in the art. 27 paragraph 4 of the Teaching Regulations.
